How to get reimbursed?

1. Please make sure to fill out the Qualtrics form with detailed explanations
2. Option 1: For reimbursement using email transfer, please provide the items below
 - Receipt
 - Bank Statement with the name of the payee and the transaction record (you could blur out the other transactions)
 - E-transfer email & Phone number
 - Student number
 - Your legal name
2. Option 2: For reimbursement using cash, please provide the items below
 - Receipt
 - Bank Statement with the name of the payee (you could blur out the other transactions)
 - Student number
 - Your legal name

*Note that cash will require you to pick it up from AMS cashier's desk in the Administration Office during AMS cashier's office hours. We recommend getting reimbursed through email transfer instead of cash reimbursement. We kindly ask that you only choose cash reimbursement as the last resort.

Textbook Subsidies Criteria

- Aims to subsidize textbook purchases \$20 per student per year.
- Opens from September 21 to October 28 for first term and January 16 to February 13 for second term
- Example of an eligible reimbursement

COURSE MATERIALS:

1. MyLab (also referred to as MyEconLab and MEL). (Ragan 17ed)

MyLab is required to do the Quizzes (for marks). You should purchase MyLab from the Pearson (publisher) website directly. See below for details. Purchasing MyLab directly from Pearson online, rather than the bookstore, avoids delays. MyLab will be the source for the required Quizzes that will be marked and comprise 10% of your course grade.

MyLab is an online homework system which includes:

- Graded assignments (i.e. Quizzes, **required for marks**)
- Practices exercises (no marks)
- Learning Tools like flashcards, links to the eText, etc.
- **Ragan eText 17ed** (the textbook for our course, recommended)

You may purchase MyLab with just the Quizzes (required for marks), or also bundled with the RAGAN eText 17ed. (recommended). The choice is yours.

You may also purchase a print copy of the Ragan eText. Go to the link on the left side that says "Print Offer". I do **not** recommend that you do this, as the eText is identical, and the Print Offer is expensive, but I leave this decision to you.

Sports Subsidies Criteria

- Please contact LFSUS Athletic Coordinator for forming and participating in sports event in which LFSUS has organized the team for. You will reimburse directly through the the coordinator if you are in an LFSUS team.

Feeding The Future Subsidies Criteria

- Aims to increase food accessibility on campus for LFS by reducing financial barriers to meals. The LFSUS may provide grocery store gift cards (value of \$20 CAD) to LFS undergraduate students who are experiencing financial hardship
- Opens from September 21 to December 1 for first term and January 16 to April 13 for second term

Professional and Academic Development Subsidies Criteria

- Covers entrance/ticket costs for LFS students to attend/participate in LFSUS specific Case Competition and Certificates limited to Food Safe 1 & 2 & Serve it Right. Students can be reimbursed up to \$15 per student per year.
- Opens from September 21 to December 1 for first term and January 16 to April 13 for second term
- Example of an eligible reimbursement
